DAY 1

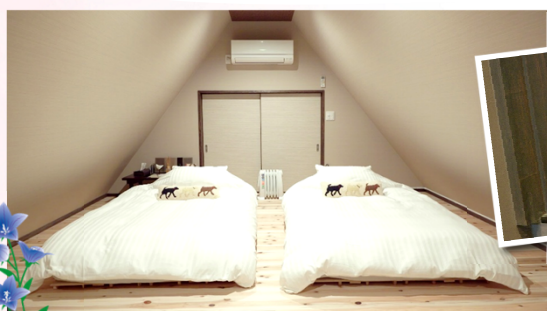
Take a local bus (Ayabus) from Ayabe Station.

Kohmyoji Temple and Nioh Mon

A National Treasure Nestled in the Satoyama

A historic temple founded by Prince Shotoku, located in the mountains of Mount Kimino. The striking red-colored mountain gate, known as the Nio Gate, is the only building in northern Kyoto designated as a National Treasure. The area is designated as part of the Kyoto-Tamba National Park, and in autumn, it attracts many hikers who come to enjoy the vibrant fall foliage. It is a popular spot, cherished as a place where both nature and history can be enjoyed.
